## What is Fall Youth Convention?

Youth from around the Diocese are invited to join us for the annual Fall Youth Convention at First Presbyterian in Missoula. Our agenda is packed full of activity for Middle School and High School students.

## When to arrive:

Plan to arrive at First Presbyterian between 5 – 6 p.m. on September 25th. At that point transportation will be the responsibility of the Diocese of Montana.

Saturday morning students will have some time to visit with the Presiding Bishop of the Episcopal Church.

In the early afternoon, students will get a tour of the college campus—led by college students who will spend some time discussing how to keep your faith on a college campus. Later everyone will have a chance to swim in the university pool.

In the evening we will focus on living into our baptismal covenant, playing some fun games and closing the day with a Compline service.

The closing Eucharist is September 27 at the Holy Spirit and the program will be dismissed from there.

## When and where the weekend is concluded:

The convention service and reception will conclude at approximately 12:00 PM. in the basement of Holy Spirit.

## Transportation:

Youth are encouraged to car pool with delegates from their local congregation. Every congregation in our diocese will be sending representatives to the convention. So – in an effort to think GREEN – we encourage car pooling.

## How do I get to First Presbyterian Church?

Take exit 105 on I-90/US Hwy 12 Van Buren Street—turn left on to Van Buren Street, choose the far right lane for about two blocks—turn right on to East Broadway—take the far left lane for about three blocks, turn left on to Madison towards the University of Montana, you will be crossing the Madison Street Bridge. Choose the right lane as you will be turning shortly after you complete the bridge. Turn right on to S 5th Street (a one way street). Continue on to 201 S. 5th Street crossing Higgins Ave at a traffic light. You are close when you see Big Dipper Ice Cream. You have gone too far if you see Sacagawea Park. Holy Spirit Parish is three blocks away on 6th Street.

## Who is the Presiding Bishop?:

Bishop Katharine Jeffers Schori is the leader of the Episcopal Church in the United States. She is the first female national leader of a mainline church **on the planet**. She is a scientist, pilot, a bishop and interested in meeting our young people. Do not miss this unusual opportunity!!
